Surprised by the sudden pain to his shin, Mario held his **leg** and stopped hitting. When the monitor arrived, Mario calmed down. Rémi was crying. His friends tried to **comfort** him. After questioning the students about what had happened, the monitor gave a **consequence** ticket to Mario and a warning ticket to Raphaëlle. The witnesses then explained to the monitor that the kick on the shin was so that Mario would stop hitting Rémi, to prevent him from getting injured.

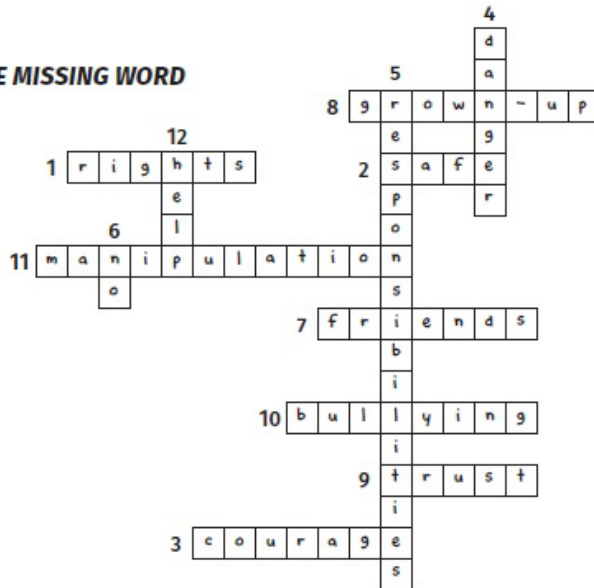
